This fall the MSFTC is presenting a three day cocker trial on a Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. The trial will be held on the property of Vinny & Linda Pestilli at 249 Sam Brown Hill Road, Brownfield, ME. The cover calls for cockers -- an old clear cut on a side hill that is growing up with young fir (pine, hemlock and spruce). The bottom cover is largely fern, low bush blueberry and intermittent grass and bushes. There are several areas to run a third series in the woods -- ample room to run a challenging and varied trial. There is also a large pond plus several creeks available for cooling off the dogs, and a little beach for swimmers.
