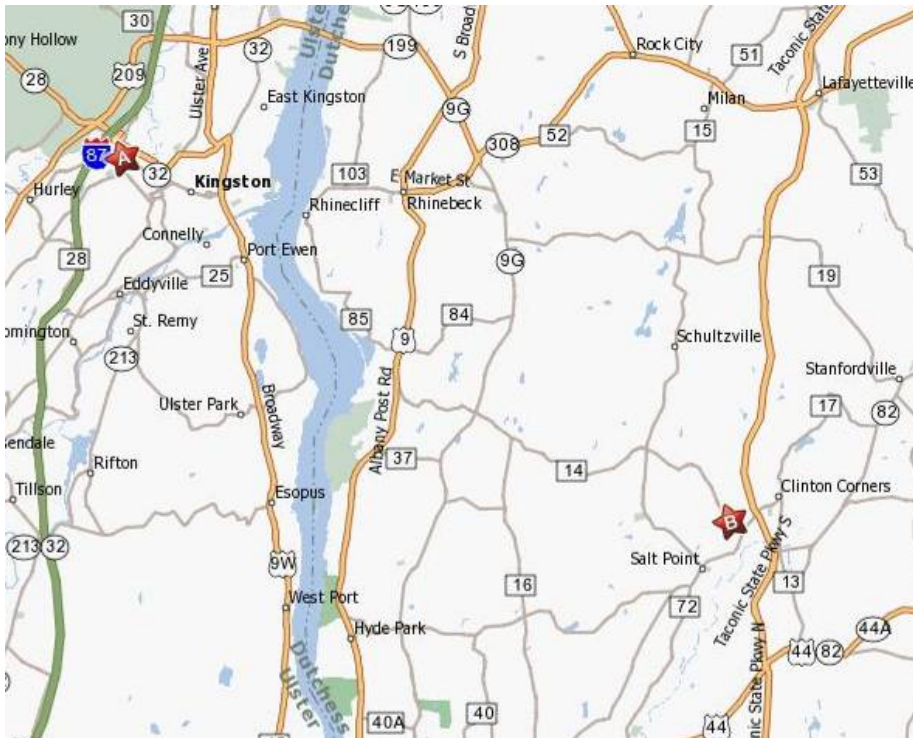

Directions to Dyson Orchard -- 1347 Hollow Road, Clinton Corners, NY

Distance from Holiday Inn to Dyson Orchard is approximately 28 miles – travel time 34 minutes. From Headquarters – 503 Washington Ave.:

1. Go north on Washington Ave toward Patroon Dr.
 2. Enter roundabout and take 3rd exit on NY-28 W/Onterora Trl .4 mi
 3. Merge onto US-209 N toward Rhinecliff Br. 3.8 mi
 4. US-209 becomes NY-199 E (Portions toll) 4.4 mi.
 5. Turn Right onto NY-9G for about 8 miles to Hollow Rd on left (CR 14)
 6. Continue on Hollow Rd. for 6.6 miles to NCC grounds on left
- OR**
5. Continue on NY-9G 4.7 mi; turn left onto slate Quarry Rd./CR-19, continue to follow CR-19 6.1 mi
 6. Merge onto Taconic State Pkwy S. 6.2 mi
 7. Take the Rt. 115/Salt Point Tpke ramp .1 mi
 8. Turn right onto Salt Point Turnpike/NY 115 .4 mi
 9. Turn right onto Hollow Rd/CR-14 .5 mi
 10. NCC Grounds on the right
