Judging commences at 8:00 am

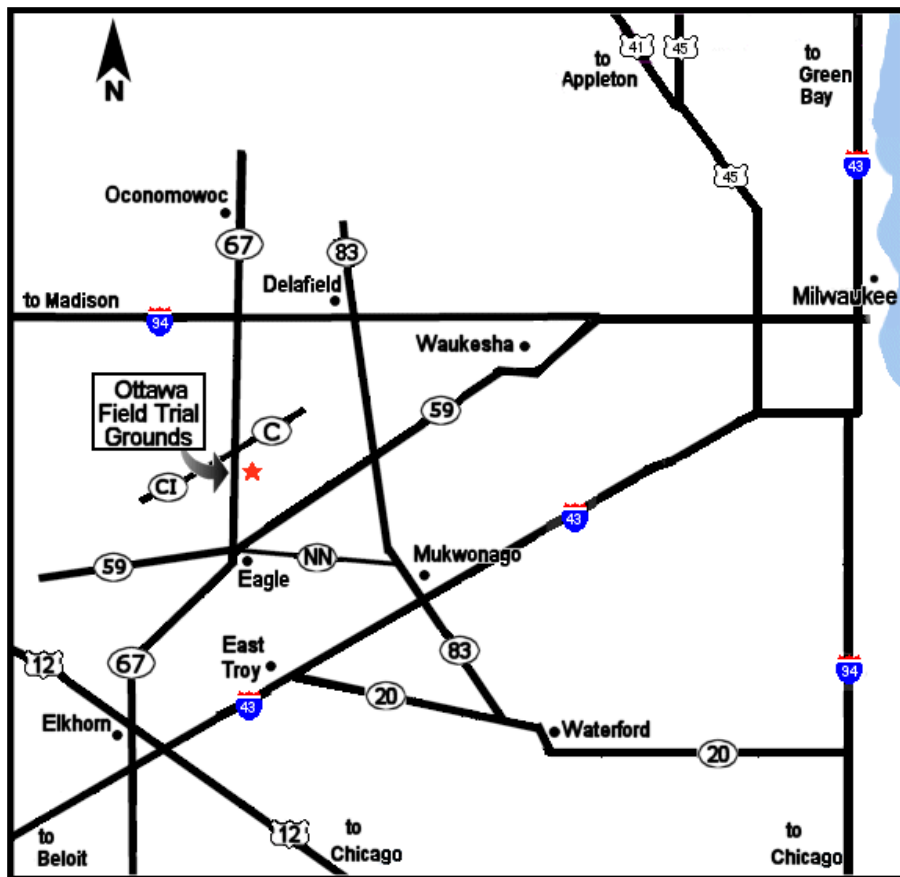

- **Please remember all participants and spectators must wear blaze orange into the field. The item must be no smaller than a hat.**
- **Smoking will not be allowed in the field.**
- **Decoys may be used in the water for the Senior & Master levels.**
- **No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted by the Hunt Test Secretary which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.**
- Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. accounts or with international money orders in U.S. funds.
- There will be no refunds for duplicate entries.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- The Club assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- Fees include AKC recording fees.
